Engineering Advisor for the MWTI In the Implementation of their Respective Outputs for the GCF - Vaisigano Catchment Project

1. The Government of Samoa via the Ministry of Works, Transport & Infrastructure (MWTI) seeks the services of an Engineering Advisor, a Professional Engineer, on a part time basis over 12 months, who has delivered on medium to large scale multidisciplinary projects.
2. This procurement is a re-advertisement for the Consultancy Services of an Engineering Advisor who will provide engineering advice for activities being implemented by the MWTI under the Green Climate Fund (GCF) Vaisigano Catchment Project (VCP). The main objective of the GCF - VCP is to strengthen the adaptive capacity and reduce the exposure of vulnerable communities, infrastructure and the built environment from extreme weather events within the Vaisigano Catchment.
3. The Engineering Advisor is to provide professional and timely engineering advice and technical inputs required by the MWTI to ensure successful delivery of their respective project activities. In undertaking the following specified services, the Advisor is obligated, as is MWTI, to ensuring conformity of activities with the relevant applicable standards such as the Samoa National Building Code, and Environmental and Social Safeguards and Occupational Health and Safety Standards. In addition, capacity building for identified MWTI personnel is intended to be achieved by way of mentoring from the Advisor.
4. The re-tender is only open to **local consultants** and will be conducted through the open competitive procedures specified in the Government of Samoa Procurement Guidelines.
